Anayat House 409-833-0649

Anayat House, Inc. provides overnight accommodations for family members of patients at local Beaumont, Texas, hospitals; especially those patients in intensive care units, parents with newborns in the neonatal intensive care unit, and individuals with out-patient service needs.

Crisis Center of Southeast Texas 409-832-6530

The Crisis Center of Southeast Texas exists for those impacted by rape, sexual assault, and suicide. They support victims, their trauma, their courage and the resolution of their crisis.

Family Services of SETX (Women and Children's Shelter) 409-833-2668

Family Services of Southeast Texas offer a facility where women and children can stay while they prepare to make a fresh start apart from their abuser. Not only are housing needs met at the shelter, but residents are also provided with meals, access to libraries and computer labs, and age-appropriate play areas for children.

Friends Helping Friends 409-882-9717

Friends Helping Friends is a community organization that provides services to clients in Southeast Texas and Southwest Louisiana. They strive to provide assistance to individuals most in need in a way that helps them preserve and promote self-esteem.

GOALS (Greater Orange Area Literacy) 409-886-4311

GOALS is an adult literacy program that is dedicated to providing adult basic education to individuals with a reading level below the 6th grade level or English as a second language (for non-English speakers). GOALS also assists with GED preparation, Family Literacy and Workplace Literacy.

Jackson Community Center 409-779-1981

Jackson Community Center provides supportive social service programs to the lower income communities and residents of East Orange. They offer tutoring, a community garden, and tax preparation assistance for low-income individuals.

OCAA (Orange Community Action Association)

Meals on Wheels 409-886-2186

Meals on Wheels provides hundreds of meals every weekday to seniors and homebound residents in Orange County. They also have four Senior Meal Centers established throughout the community.

OCARC, Inc. 409-886-1363

OCARC provides intellectually challenged adults an opportunity for vocational training. They also provide daily rehabilitation services, which focus on building social, cognitive, and self-help skills.

Recovery Council of Southeast Texas - Right Choice of Orange County 409-670-9524

Right Choice is an outpatient treatment program with sessions for individuals or groups. Right Choice utilizes a multitude of approaches to include brief intervention, relapse prevention therapy, behavioral therapy, and motivational counseling.

Recovery Council of Southeast Texas - Unity Treatment Center 409-842-2408

Unity Treatment Center is a male, inpatient treatment facility which offers individual counseling, group counseling and education on how to maintain an alcohol/drug free lifestyle after discharge.

The Salvation Army 409-291-8400

The Salvation Army is a ministry which provides a food pantry and offers social service assistance to individuals.

Salvation Army Boys and Girls Club 409-291-8400

The Boys and Girls Club includes after-school care, summer day camp, as well as sporting opportunities for our youth.

Samaritan Counseling Center of Southeast Texas 409-727-6400

Samaritan Counseling Center of Southeast Texas is a counseling organization that uses the concept of mind, body and spirit to promote the healing and growth of people and the reconciliation of couples, families and organizations.

Shorkey Center 409-838-6568

The Shorkey Center provides Occupational Therapy, Physical Therapy, Speech Therapy, Applied Behavior Analysis (ABA) and Aquatic Therapy to children. The Center also provides a day treatment school for children with Autism and those with Down Syndrome.

Southeast Texas Hospice 409-886-0622

Southeast Texas Hospice is dedicated to caring for terminally ill patients and their families.

Spindletop Center - Tejas Center 409-883-3864

Spindletop Center provides a variety of behavioral health care services to people with mental illness, intellectual and developmental disabilities and chemical dependency. Spindletop's Tejas Center is located in Orange.

Stable-Spirit 409-365-5277

Stable-Spirit provides the community with opportunities that inspire positive mental, emotional, and physical health through professionally guided interaction with horses. They offer EAGALA Certified Sessions, Hippotherapy Sessions - partnered with Kids Therapy SET, and Therapeutic Riding Lessons.

2019 At a Glance

In 2019, over 11,480 Orange County residents were served through our Partner Agencies. Some of those services include...

- 118,820 hot meals delivered to the homes of over 450 elderly individuals.
- 20 clients provided with overnight accommodations while their loved ones received medical treatment.
- 51 families provided with palliative services for a loved one.
- 1,447 children housed, fed, educated, mentored, made feel safe and healthy.
- 22 individuals helped with GED, ESL, or adult literacy.
- 1,175 clients received crisis support and education regarding traumatic situations.
- 97 women with their children provided refuge from domestic violence.
- 24 clients provided with occupational training.
- 61 clients assisted with income tax services.
- 288 clients received drug/alcohol counseling and treatment.
- 148 clients received counseling for mental health issues.
- 90 clients received Physical Therapy, Occupational Therapy, Speech Therapy and/or Behavioral Therapy.
- 164 disabled clients served.
- 7,601 clients provide clothing, food, furniture, utility and rent assistance.
