As we reflect on 2024, I am proud to share a couple of major achievements, a tremendous milestone, and more proud moments. One of the most significant accomplishments this year was the completion of our Community Needs Assessment. This comprehensive project, involving interviews with 48 community stakeholders, focus groups, and feedback from an online survey, provided invaluable insights into the most pressing needs in our community. It has set the stage for future programs and strategic initiatives that will address gaps and drive positive change.

We were thrilled to host our very first Community Resource Fair, bringing together nonprofits and local organizations to showcase the incredible resources available in Orange County. It was a true testament to the power of collaboration and the collective effort to strengthen our community.

Our volunteer-driven initiatives were another highlight this year. From our Day of Caring, where hundreds of volunteers dedicated their time to local nonprofits, to Feed the Funnel, a partnership with Dow, which helped provide meals for families in need. We also continued Project Backpack and Project Angel Tree. These efforts would not have been possible without the generosity and dedication of our volunteers.

We continued to invest in nonprofit capacity-building as well, offering valuable training sessions on social media best practices, effective board governance, and more. These programs provided local organizations with the tools and knowledge to enhance their impact and operate more efficiently.

Our campaign that began in 2023 and continued receiving pledge throughout 2024 was the most successful in our history, with pledges over \$1.4 million. This achievement would not have been possible without the unwavering support of our donors, whose generosity continues to fuel our mission and help us improve the health, education, and financial security of those in our community.

I want to extend a heartfelt thank you to each of our donors, volunteers, partners, and supporters. Your commitment enables us to build a brighter future for all of Orange County.
