In 2017, over 17,575 Orange County residents were served through our Partner Agencies. Some of those services include...

Friends Helping Friends is a community organization that provides services to clients in Southeast Texas and Southwest Louisiana. They strive to provide assistance to individuals most in need in a way that helps them preserve and promote self-esteem.

### GOALS (GREATER ORANGE AREA LITERACY) 409-886-4311

GOALS is an adult literacy program that is dedicated to providing adult basic education to individuals with a reading level below the 6th grade level or English as a second language (for non-English speakers). GOALS also assists with GED preparation, Family Literacy and Workplace Literacy.

### JACKSON COMMUNITY CENTER 409-779-1981

Jackson Community Center provides supportive social service programs to the lower income communities and residents of East Orange. They offer tutoring, a community garden, and tax preparation assistance for low-income individuals.
